The [Streets and Drains Division](#) provides maintenance, repair and replacement to a network of 364 miles of Local, Major and County roads, street lighting, traffic control signs, and 500 miles of sidewalks. They investigate residential storm water issues and work to maintain a highly efficient storm water drainage system as regulated by the Oakland County Storm Water Permit and Michigan Department of Environmental Quality.

HOURS 7:00 am – 3:30 pm. Overtime is required; employees are expected to work 50% of offered overtime.

DUTIES (Not All-Inclusive)

Performs general labor and maintenance work on asphalt and cement roadways and storm water drains. Snow removal on major and subdivision roads. Operates trucks, tractors, loaders, sweeper, etc. Uses non-power tools including shovels, rakes, wrenches, wheelbarrows, etc. Operates and performs routine maintenance on light power equipment including chain saws, lawnmowers, jackhammers, etc. Performs other similar work assignments.

REQUIREMENTS

- High school graduate (or GED equivalent).
- Valid Michigan driver license with a good driving record at the time of application (based on City of Troy standards). Prefer current commercial driver license (CDL). Out of state applicants must provide current driving record at time of application and obtain State of Michigan license within one (1) month of appointment.
- Will be required to obtain a CDL (Commercial Driver's License), including air brakes and (N) endorsement, and Medical Card as required by the State of Michigan before probation period is complete.
- As a condition of employment, the successful candidate must pass a pre-employment physical including drug screen.

PREFERENCES

- Recent experience as a laborer or light equipment operation. Indicate all outdoor work experience including seasonal and temporary work.
- Recent experience as an asphalt and concrete laborer.
- Recent experience with underground storm water drains.
- Recent experience with commercial snow removal.
- Knowledge of the operation of mechanical and power equipment and traffic and safety rules and regulations concerning the use of this equipment.
- Current CDL (Commercial Driver's License).
