HOURS 7:00 am—3:30 pm. Overtime is required; employees are expected to work 50% of offered overtime.

DUTIES (Not All-Inclusive)

Performs storm and sanitary sewer maintenance and clean-out, water main maintenance and general labor/maintenance work. Marks underground utilities. Snow removal on major and subdivision roads. Operates and performs routine maintenance on light power equipment including chain saws, boring machines, lawnmowers, jackhammers, etc. Uses non-power tools including shovels, rakes, wrenches, wheelbarrows, etc. Operates trucks, tractors, loaders, sewer cleaning equipment, etc. Performs other similar work assignments.

REQUIREMENTS

- High school graduate (or GED equivalent).
- Valid Michigan driver license with good driving record at time of application (based on City of Troy standards). Prefer current commercial driver license (CDL). Out of state applicants must provide current driving record at time of application and obtain State of Michigan license within one (1) month of appointment.
- Will be required to obtain a CDL (Commercial Driver's License), including air brakes and (N) endorsement, and Medical Card as required by the State of Michigan before probation period is complete.
- As a condition of employment, the successful candidate must pass a pre-employment physical including drug screen.

PREFERENCES

- Strongly prefer at least 2 years of recent experience working on water main systems.
- Recent paid work experience as a laborer or light equipment operator. Indicate all outdoor work experience including seasonal and temporary work.
- Knowledge of the operation of mechanical and power equipment and traffic and safety rules and regulations concerning the use of this equipment.
- Current State of Michigan S-4 Water Distribution Certification.
- Current CDL (Commercial Driver's License).
